Benching Times

- All Quilts need to be benched at the Exhibition Hall in the Margaret River Recreation Centre between 1pm and 3pm on Thursday, 3rd November 2022.
- All Quilts need to be collected between 3pm and 4pm on Saturday 5th November. Prize money will be distributed by the Steward upon collection.

Regulations

All quilts must have a hanging sleeve (at least a 2" drop).

CLASS QU1: TRADITIONAL QUILT

Featuring a traditional design or pattern. May be pieced and quilted, appliqué and quilted, or a combination of.

CLASS QU2: MODERN DESIGN QUILT

Quilts that reflect a modern design aesthetic.

Characteristics may include, but not limited to: use of bold color and print, high contrast and graphic areas of solid color, improvisational piecing, minimalism, expansive negative space, alternate grid work, functionality of the finished quilt and the updating of classic quilt designs ("modern traditionalism").

CLASS QU3: SCRAP QUILT

A quilt made from leftovers, crumbs and recycled material. A multitude of fabrics and designs nothing wasted. Anything goes in choice of colour and style

CLASS QU5: QUILT DISPLAYING USE OF SPECIAL TECHNIQUES

Unusual techniques such as embroidered quilts, English paper pieced quilts, cathedral windows, miniature quilts, whole cloth quilts, heavily embellished quilts and quilts using unusual quilting techniques such as sashiko or boro.

CLASS QU6: QUILT CREATIONS

For Quilts that aren't Quilts.

Here we find all patchwork, artistic and quilting techniques used to create bags, wearables (Jackets, Dresses etc), home décor items, jewellery or anything that isn't a wall hanging, a bed quilt or a quilt that hangs!

CLASS QU7: DISPLAY ONLY (NOT JUDGED, ENTERED FOR DISPLAY ONLY)

If you have a quilt or quilted item that you are happy to be shown but don't wish to be entered in for judging

CLASS QU8: BEST OF SHOW

Championship Class. Based on highest points of all Quilting entries and the judges final decision.

All exhibits are automatically eligible. You do not need to enter this class online.

CLASS QU9: BEST USE OF COLOUR

Championship Class.

All exhibits are automatically eligible. You do not need to enter this class online.

CLASS QU10: MOST INNOVATIVE

Championship Class.

All exhibits are automatically eligible. You do not need to enter this class online.

CLASS QU11: VIEWER'S CHOICE

Based on votes by the public during Exhibition Hall open times.

All exhibits are automatically entered into this class. You do not need to enter online.
